Amended Update on Forest Road 300 ---

The opening date for the remainder of Forest Road 300 and all adjacent roads in the Rim Lakes Recreation Area is set for no later than Friday, April 28, 2017. A recent check of the roads revealed several areas that are still under several feet of snow and remain impassible. In addition to the snow and wet roads, the Rim Lakes Area has several trees that have fallen into and across roads. These hazards will need to be mitigated prior to opening as well.

Numerous visitors who have chosen to enter the Rim Lakes Recreation Area against the standing closure order by cutting fence, cutting locks, or going around locked gates have gotten stuck in the mud on the saturated roads as well as in snow drifts. Visitors who enter closed areas are subject to fines and the costs to repair resource damage they cause. These roads remain closed to provide for the safety of the public as well as to protect the roads from additional damage. The Black Mesa Ranger District is working closely with the Coconino National Forest to coordinate opening the A-S side of FR 300 with the Mogollon Rim Ranger District's opening of their side of Forest Road 300.

FYI – Not obeying the signs is a Class B Misdemeanor. The maximum fine is \$5,000, 6 months in a federal correctional facility, and/or both, not including the cost to "fix" the roads/forest if damaged

The Feral/Wild horses have found their way into Forest Lakes!

They have now traveled across the highway from South of Forest Lakes and are roaming around inside the Subdivision. The sense is that they are going to become a nuisance this summer.

Here is some great advice from our Deputy Robert McKeever on how to deal with them. He strongly discourages feeding and watering them as they will continue to come back. Don't go near them. They are wild and protective of their herds. Deputy McKeever has already had one charge at him while trying to get them off the highway. Please heed this advice and don't put the horses in jeopardy of having to be removed against their own free will. If you feel unsafe, you can call Robert and he will deal with them.
