What is CodeRED?

CodeRED is a free service that alerts residents and businesses about time-sensitive general and emergency situations that are either imminent or occurring in their communities. Coconino County is using the service to keep residents informed about wildfires and other emergencies, including severe weather.

CodeRED allows geographically based delivery, which requires a street address to ensure that information is delivered to the proper individuals in a given situation. The system works for both landline and cellphones, but both require an address so that residents receive location-specific notifications.

We urge all residents to enroll and receive emergency alerts through Code**RED**.
