Coconino County enacts Stage 2 fire restrictions

Stage 2 fire restrictions began at 8 a.m. today, Thursday, June 22, across Coconino County. Fire restrictions are to help protect public health by reducing the number of human-caused wildfires

The County has been in Stage 1 fire restrictions since June 15. The County is enacting Stage 2 restrictions due to forecasted weather and very high fire danger. Restrictions are in coordination with Coconino National Forest and the Arizona Department of Fire and Forestry Management.

Restrictions are the same as Stage I Fire Restrictions. Additionally, Stage II Fire Restrictions prohibit other activities which may include (but are not limited to) --- You CANNOT operate any motorized vehicle or internal combustion engine (such as a chainsaw) without a Forest Service approved spark arrestor, weld, or use an explosive.
