**Subject:** Final Update on recent incidents

In this morning's report, we reported "All fire fighters were removed from the Gentry Fire on Tuesday afternoon due to the police situation. The fire lines are secure and the Forest Service will continue to monitor the fire with the assistance of local law enforcement."

This afternoon, the fire fighters from both the U.S. Forest Service and the Forest Lakes Fire District are re-entering the Gentry Fire area to put out any hot spots that still remain. Each unit returning to the fire area will have a law enforcement team with them. This is being done as a precaution only. If you are in Forest Lakes, I'm sure you are experiencing watching a "parade" of our many officials that have been stationed in our area. This is to let you know what is happening, even as I write.

After the fire fighters are back in the fire area, the law enforcement teams will be returning to base camp and then demobilizing from our area. There have been no further sightings of the "person of interest". However, please continue to use cautionary measures when travelling about the community. As always, if you suspect any strange activity, please report it immediately. Calling 911 is the best way to make a report.

This will be the last posting I will be sending regarding both the Gentry Fire and the police situation unless there is anything new to report. We are in the "no news is good news" phase of reporting.
