RUMMAGE SALE coming soon (Labor Day Week-end) WE NEED YOUR TREASURES

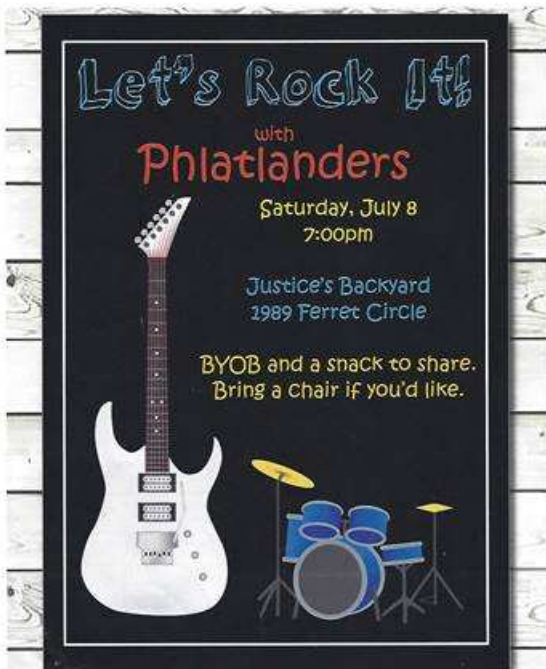
