Minutes of the regular board meeting

April 22, 2006

Wendell talked about researching the prices on buying chairs. A motion was presented to allow him to buy 30 new chairs. The motion was approved.

Jan Walls reported that there are now 536 FLOA members. She also reported that the kids would like to have the basketball hoop put back up, but a sound barrier has to be put in place first. The school board will get estimates on a block wall. Jan also reported the school bus has broken down for the 6<sup>th</sup> time.

Charlie Magee talked about fire prevention and urged everyone to talk to their neighbors about fire safety.

Virgilee reported on the newsletter for Cheryl. There were some mistakes made by the printer, but were fixed at the printer's expense. Mack presented Virgilee with a gift certificate for all the hard work she has done.

Mack also discussed presenting a plaque to Debbie Holyoak of the Postal Service for all her help in keeping the Post Office in its present location. He would also like to write a letter to her supervisor. A motion was made, seconded, and approved.

Jessie suggested to get FLOA members e-mail addresses to communicate information about upcoming meetings.

Mack entered a motion to close the meeting. It was seconded and approved. The meeting adjourned at 3:05PM.
