Frank announced that there will be a CPR class for all CERT members on June 21st. There will be a drug enforcement officer on July 3rd in the library at 6PM speaking on Marijuana fields in the forest and how to avoid them.

Cindy Schaidler announced that on June 19th at 6:30 PM at the fire station, there will be training on the most common drugs of abuse and the slang words used by kids.

Virgilee Scholl reported that there are now 585 paid members in FLOA. She is still looking for someone to take over the membership job.

Jan Walls reported that the auxiliary has purchased a Resusci-annie for the fire department to teach CPR.

The ice cream social will be on June 30th.

Mack reported that there will be no green waste site. There were too many complaints. He is working on possibly getting the old site back from ADOT.

The cell tower should be up and running soon.

Frank reported on the Memorial Day breakfast. The total income was \$6,066.24. Bugle's donated the biscuits and a friend of Mack's in the Yuma area donated the gravy.
