**Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting**

**July 21, 2007**

The July meeting of the Forest Lakes Owners Association was called to order at 2:00 PM by Mack Hume. Mack led us in the pledge. There were 55 people present.

Karen Foncannon read the minutes from the June 2007 board meeting. The minutes were approved.

Jane Cummins gave the treasurer's report. The beginning checking account balance was \$22,168.10. The ending balance is \$19,368.49. There is \$78.33 in petty cash. The CD's total \$101,352.85. Total assets are \$120,799.67. The treasurer's report was approved.

Virgilee Scholl reported that there are now 586 paid FLOA members. She announced that Ben Froehlich will be taking on the membership duties. Cheryl Rife will still be the editor of the newsletter. Becky Johnson will be doing circulations. Jesse Bonfeld will be the coordinator.

Jan Walls reported that the auxiliary would like to thank everyone involved in the picnic. There will be a Chili Cookoff on Saturday July 28<sup>th</sup> and also an Ice Cream social on the lawn next to the fire station.

Mack thanked all the volunteers who helped on the picnic. It was a great success and the best turnout to date.

Frank Astemborski reported on the picnic. The total profit was \$3,356.50 which will be shared with the auxiliary. Frank announced that there would be another CERT training October 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>. Frank reported that the forest service contacted him to say someone has dumped household items in the forest. There is a large fine for those who are caught.

Mack is still working on finding a green waste site. He is sending information to Kate Klein on how many loads were taken in at the old green waste site. Between May 1, 2005 and June 1, 2006 there were 2858 loads. Mack thanked Gene and all the volunteers who helped on the highway cleanup.

Wendell Lolling reported that elections of FLOA board members will be September 1<sup>st</sup>. There are four openings on the board. Three people have volunteered to serve and he asked if anyone is interested to contact him. There can be nine to fifteen people on the board.

Jan Walls reported that the county is now allowing gray water from cabins to be used to water yards. She handed out information to those interested.

Mack reported on the cell tower. He has talked to someone from ALLTEL about their own cell to the tower. They will be contacting Mack soon.

Jim Paxon gave a wonderful talk on the Rodeo-Chediski fire and fire prevention. He also had a book signing afterwards.
